

CITRIS Headquarters Building



This new building, the Davis Hall North Replacement Building, will house the headquarters of a new interdisciplinary research institute, the Center for Information Technology Research in the Interest of Society (CITRIS). Spaces include flexible research facilities for the design of societal-scale information systems, a center for distance learning and a state-of-the-art nanofabrication laboratory.

The project is funded through the California Institutes for Science and Innovation, and private gifts.
